

Successful push for more transparency (Open Science)

Top-down and bottom-up initiatives



However, its practical implementation is lagging behind

Studying researchers' OS-attitudes

Study

- Interviews with 15 researchers
- Reasons/feelings for (not) adopting OS-practices

Results

- Overwhelmingly many resources
- Ingrained scientific habits difficult to change
- Researchers may feel they have missed the boat

Conclusion

Low-key OS-introduction is lacking



Why use a chat-bot?


